## **Economic Opportunity Program, Inc. Annual Meeting Celebration - February 24, 2026**

Elmira, N.Y. (February 20, 2026) – It's a **#NewSeason** at the Ernie Davis Community Center (EDCC)! EOP, Inc.'s **Annual Meeting Celebration** will be taking place in the EDCC gym on February 24, 2026 from 2:30-6pm. Additionally, the **ACCEL Clinic** is expanding its preventative health screening services into Schuyler County through a new partnership with Schuyler Head Start and WIC.

The first clinic will take place on **February 24 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Human Services Complex in Montour Falls NY**, providing lead screening for children enrolled in Schuyler Head Start.

The ACCEL Clinic is a collaborative partnership between Arnot Health, the Chemung County Health Department, the Economic Opportunity Program, Inc., and LECOM (Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine), and is underwritten by Excellus BlueCross BlueShield. The Clinic was created to address the social determinants of health influencing Chemung County and is now extending that mission to Schuyler County.

In addition to lead screening, the ACCEL Clinic offers blood pressure screenings and other preventative health services in Elmira, with plans to expand available screenings in Schuyler County through this partnership.

This collaboration reflects a shared commitment to access to health care, child and youth care, and improved health outcomes for children and families across the region.

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
